Dear Parents:

My name is Maggie Keefe Bruce and I am the St. Norbert Youth Ministry Coordinator. St. Norbert Youth Ministry is a vibrant and important program with opportunities for High School youth. Teens connect with the Church and feel a part of our Catholic Community through a variety of events blending faith formation, service, and recreation.

St. Norbert Teen Mass is a wonderful liturgy held on various Sunday nights of each month. Please encourage your teen to attend and to bring a friend. All high school teens are welcome to gather in the Vineyard after all Teen Masses for pizza, refreshments, and visiting; and then “Compass” begins where teens can participate in activities and discussions which connect them to our Catholic faith. Once a month after the regular 5:30 Mass we hold “Teens Keeping The Faith Alive” which allows high schoolers to gather and have fun while digging deeper into the readings and Gospels. Our various retreats throughout the year are another important faith component of our Ministry. For our younger members, we have the Freshman and Sophomore Winter Lock-In in January; and for our Juniors and Seniors, we offer Kairos in November the weekend before Thanksgiving.

We would love to see families attend the 5:30 outdoor Mass In The Meadow at Our Lady Of The Brook on August 26; and then everyone is invited to help with the festivities by setting up, greeting Parishioners, serving dinner, coordinating/playing games, and cleaning up afterwards. Please encourage your teen to attend that special Mass as well as our Kick Off Dinner following the Teen Mass on September 9. Food, conversation, baggo, and open gym will be enjoyed by all! This is a great chance for us to celebrate this new year of Youth Ministry and Teen Mass. Fr. Tom Quirk is the Celebrant at our November 11 Teen Mass with a celebration afterwards, and our Christmas Party is on December 16 following the Teen Mass.

Your high school teen has received a Grapevine flyer in the mail describing in detail what our Youth Ministry did this past summer and what is planned for this semester. The Youth Ministry events for the entire year are listed on our SNYM calendar. Please review and discuss the Grapevine Calendar with your high schooler. Help your teen to choose a mixture of faith formation, service projects, and recreational events. We invite you and/or your teen to join the “St. Norbert Youth Ministry” Facebook Group to stay informed about upcoming events and changes since things can and will be added throughout the year. The Church Bulletin and St. Norbert & Our Lady Of The Brook Parish website are also great ways to stay informed.

In closing, I pray that the teens enjoy the multitude of opportunities we offer them through our High School Youth Ministry. Jesus tells us that He is the vine and calls us to be the branches. We adults are the stem of the Vine, planning events, getting information out, and collecting permission slips. The high schoolers are the branches of the Vine, devoting their time and enthusiasm in a variety of ways.
