Nightly Family Prayers

Build positive prayer habits by practicing our tradition's common prayers at bedtime with your children.

- 1. Say the Hail Mary or Our Father.
- 2. Ask your children what they are thankful for.
- 3. Ask them if they have any special intensions.
- 4. End with the Glory Be or Act of Contrition.

Alternate the four prayers so your kids can learn the words to all of them.

Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against You whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Amen.

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be they name; they kingdom come, they will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.
